

# St Bs **Mission Partners**



Annette Jandrell has worked with Youth With A Mission (YWAM) since 2000; she spent 8 years in Cambodia and has been based in Harpenden, England, since 2009. She is the leader of a 6 month YWAM Community Development School (CDS) which equips and prepares participants from developing countries for community development ministry in their own communities.

Latest news from Annette: "I was in Togo in January and February to follow up with two of the 2015 CDS (Community Development School) students, forward-plan with them and evaluate the school. The Togolese students now have a great understanding and passion for community development. I also did some staff training for the next Togo CDS in 2018 and ran two community development seminars with two local churches. 25- 30 people attended each session.

Earlier in April, I attended a YWAM Europe Gathering in Albania and taught at a YWAM School of Frontier Missions (SoFM) in the Netherlands last week. I am also preparing for the September 2017 CDS in Harpenden. We have already accepted two students and have had several other applications and enquiries."

To make training more accessible to those in developing countries, Annette is hoping to design a shorter version of the 6 month CDS which would be a 4 week in-country community development seminar."
