Latest news from Pedro and Annu:

Pedro writes: "God is doing amazing things here. People are coming to faith all the time. Recently three Jewish Brazilian families have come to faith. They were baptised in the Jordan River and now are growing in their faith. They have so many questions. Pray for the husbands who haven't yet made a commitment. We are working on them.

A few weeks ago we went to Samaria and our guide was an Israeli guy called Ran. Back in 1991 he came to Beit Immanuel and we spoke. It was the first time in his life that he heard about Jesus, the Jewish Messiah. After 22 years of praying for him, the scales finally fell from his eyes and he gave his life to Jesus. He has such a passion for the Word of God and it is great to see how the Bible comes to life when he talks about Abraham and other characters and things that happened here. I felt like a proud spiritual father to him.

Our Passover evening was filled with lots of joy. Pray especially for Yonatan, Gabi and Yochanan who are not believers yet. We spent the evening talking and discussing the Bible and Jesus. The next day Gabi sent me a message saying that it was a very special time especially studying the Bible together. He also said that he hopes for more. Pray for their salvation.

We so much appreciate all you do for us. Your love is something we cannot take for granted. Thank you so much for your prayers. We also pray for St Barnabas and all that you are involved with, especially the big move to Solar House."
