



St Barnabas Missional Communities

Our Missional Communities are groups with an outward focus and consist of people with like-minded interests meeting in the local community. Through Missional Communities, small groups of St Bs members are able to experience God's transforming work in their own lives, while uniting with others to have an impact on the world around us.

Homeless Outreach feeds over 60 guests every Sunday, partners with Together in Barnet to provide winter shelter and seeks to help meet the physical and spiritual needs of some of the most vulnerable men and women within our local community.

The Finchley Jam takes place on the third Thursday of each month at The Bohemia with sessions led by a house band. There's opportunity for singers, instrumentalists and audience members to get involved, have great conversation and generally chill out.

Prison Ministry is a small group of people with an interest in prison ministry and a desire to get involved through prayer, letter writing and the Angel Tree Christmas Gift project, as well by going into prisons to help with restorative justice and evangelism courses for inmates.

Enfield Neighbourhood has a heart to see God bless, heal and transform the Enfield area. They meet together twice a month to encourage and equip each other through building good relationships with neighbours through acts of kindness and local events; praying for God's blessing on the community and engaging in social action.

La Roca want to see lives transformed through the love of Jesus, and share the message of Jesus with the Ibero-American community in North London.

N12 is formed of a number of activities with a three-fold aim, to reach out to the N12 community with the love and message of Jesus Christ, to worship God together, and to bless each other in gathering together for prayer and encouragement.

Families is set up with the intentions of supporting one another through family life with God's love. They meet monthly on a Saturday afternoon for family events and to pray with one another.

God at Work is a community that supports people who want to share their faith and God's love in their place of work. They meet regularly to encourage one another, worship and pray and are sent out to be salt and light in their workplace.
