
## I AM THE LORD YOUR GOD





Noses comes down Moses Boes 17 MOUNT SINAL



19 On the first day of the third month after the Israelites left Egypt – on that very day – they came to the Desert of Sinai. <sup>2</sup> After they set out from Rephidim, they entered the Desert of Sinai, and Israel camped there in the desert in front of the mountain.

<sup>3</sup> Then Moses went up to God, and the LORD called to him from the mountain and said, 'This is what you are to say to the descendants of Jacob and what you are to tell the people of Israel: 4 "You yourselves have seen what I did to Egypt, and how I carried you on eagles' wings and brought you to myself.

<sup>5</sup> Now if you obey me fully and keep my covenant, then out of all nations you will be my treasured possession. Although the whole earth is mine, <sup>6</sup> you will be for me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation." These are the words you are to speak to the Israelites.'

<sup>7</sup> So Moses went back and summoned the elders of the people and set before them all the words the LORD had commanded him to speak. 8 The people all responded together, 'We will do everything the LORD has said.' So Moses brought their answer back to the LORD.

<sup>9</sup> The LORD said to Moses, 'I am going to come to you in a dense cloud, so that the people will hear me speaking with you and will always put their trust in you.' Then Moses told the LORD what the people had said.

<sup>20</sup> The LORD descended to the top of Mount Sinai and called Moses to the top of the mountain. So Moses went up 21 and the LORD said to him, 'Go down and warn the people so they do not force their way through to see the LORD and many of them perish.

<sup>22</sup> Even the priests, who approach the LORD, must consecrate themselves, or the LORD will break out against them.'

<sup>25</sup> So Moses went down to the people and told them.

<sup>18</sup> When the people saw the thunder and lightning and heard the trumpet and saw the mountain in smoke, they trembled with fear. They stayed at a distance <sup>19</sup> and said to Moses, 'Speak to us yourself and we will listen. But do not let God speak to us or we will die.'

<sup>20</sup> Moses said to the people, 'Do not be afraid. God has come to test you, so that the fear of God will be with you to keep you from sinning.'

<sup>21</sup> The people remained at a distance, while Moses approached the thick darkness where God was.

<sup>2</sup> Aaron answered them, 'Take off the gold earrings that your wives, your sons and your daughters are wearing, and bring them to me.' <sup>3</sup> So all the people took off their earrings and brought them to Aaron.



<sup>4</sup> He took what they handed him and made it into an idol cast in the shape of a calf, fashioning it with a tool. Then they said, 'These are your gods, Israel, who brought you up out of Egypt.'



<sup>9</sup> 'I have seen these people,' the LORD said to Moses, 'and they are a stiff-necked people. <sup>10</sup> Now leave me alone so that my anger may burn against them and that I may destroy them. Then I will make you into a great nation.'

<sup>11</sup> But Moses sought the favour of the LORD his God.



<sup>14</sup> Then the LORD relented and did not bring on his people the disaster he had threatened.



<sup>19</sup> When Moses approached the camp and saw the calf and the dancing, his anger burned and he threw the tablets out of his hands, breaking them to pieces at the foot of the mountain. <sup>20</sup> And he took the calf the people had made and burned it in the fire; then he ground it to powder, scattered it on the water and made the Israelites drink it. **Exodus 32** 



<sup>21</sup> He said to Aaron, 'What did these people do to you, that you led them into such great sin?' <sup>22</sup> 'Do not be angry, my lord,' Aaron answered. 'You know how prone these people are to evil.



<sup>23</sup> They said to me, "Make us gods who will go before us. As for this fellow Moses who brought us up out of Egypt, we don't know what has happened to him."24 So I told them, "Whoever has any gold jewellery, take it off." Then they gave me the gold, and I threw it into the fire, and out came this calf!'




