About Malcolm and Kerstin Gray:

The Grays work with WEC International in Thailand where they lead a team of around 40 missionaries reaching the unreached, mainly in the rural areas, through church planting. They live around 5 hours drive north of Bangkok. Their daughter Amy is at Grace International School in Chiangmai, three hours from Malcolm and Kerstin.

Latest news from the Grays:

"After a refreshing six-month home leave, we returned to Thailand in June. There has been much to do to catch up on situations and administration while we've been away. Two weeks after arriving, we led our annual conference, at which Peter Landry and David Farnworth selflessly assisted by overseeing the kids/youth programme. Thank you, again St Bs for supporting us by sending helpers! Since then, we have travelled around, visiting team members and church leaders, trying to get back to speed on various developments while we've been away.

One initiative that started while we were away, is a discipleship training school. Emerging leaders will attend for five block days every month for about 9 months. We're looking forward to seeing what fruit will come of that. Praise the Lord that we are currently corresponding with a good number of enquirers and welcoming some new missionaries to our team. This is much needed!

Kerstin has been in pain for a number of years now. In the last 2 weeks, it has been quite bad, and it does make it difficult to concentrate on what she needs to get on with."


