About Kerry: Kerry works in Cameroon as part of a church-planting team working among the Fulbe people who are traditionally Muslim.

Latest news from Kerry: Kerry is now in the UK until January, spending time with family, friends and supporters. She will be visiting a lot of people from September to November around the UK, to report on the work in Cameroon. Her four team colleagues continue with the work in Cameroon, discipling Fulbe believers and reaching out to those who want to learn more about Jesus.

This time in the UK is a particular opportunity for Kerry to spend time with those in the UK who support her ministry and who diligently pray for the team in Cameroon, "The praver support we have for the work is incredible!"

There are specifically four Fulbe believers that Kerry and her team are investing in, who are active in sharing their faith and leading others to Jesus - this is a great joy and encouragement to them, and an example to the other believers to be bold in their witness.

Their hospital in the far north continues to be a care centre of integrity that honours Jesus and is a witness to the area.
