



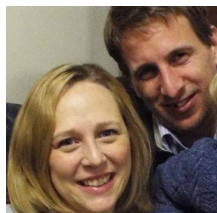
St Barnabas Mission Partner

Richard Harvey

Richard writes and teaches on what it means to be Jewish and believe in Jesus. This involves writing, research, teaching, training, mentoring, academic work and evangelism. Today he is sharing his story at 'Refill', an event in a church in Cambridge aimed at people who are not Christians but who are open to the gospel message. In November Richard will be travelling to Wittenberg, Germany, where Luther launched the Protestant Reformation 500 years ago. He will be meeting with the Mayor and presenting his petition of over 8000 signatures to remove the Jew-Pig, an offensive anti-semitic sculpture on the wall of Luther's parish church. His book "Luther and the Jews: Putting Right the Lies" has recently been published.

They have recently returned to Malawi having had a great break in the UK, catching up with friends, family and churches. A team from the Base recently returned from an outreach in a village where they trained pastors, saw many healings and where people were desperate to hear about God. Next month they will be travelling by road to South Africa to a YWAM conference, where Chris will show his Bible Distributor App with the aim of 'Ending Bible Poverty'.
