## Mark & Rahel Landrum

Mark & Rahel Landrum work with Jews for Jesus in Sydney, Australia, where they enjoy ministering the truth and love of Jesus with Jewish people in Sydney and other places where they travel, through

personal visits with Jewish people, going on the streets with Gospel tracts, teaching group Bible studies and teaching in churches about the Jewish roots of the faith. They recently had High Holidays, Jewish New Year and Day of Atonement services which were attended by unsaved Jewish people who heard the Gospel, and one of them prayed to receive the Lord on Rosh Hashana. They are currently on a trip to the UK to reconnect with old and new friends and to share about their ministry through personal contact and speaking engagements.

## Bianca Parish

Bianca Parish heads up Eden Plaistow, part of Eden-Network. Eden is a network of teams living and working long-term on deprived estates, building deep and open friendships with their neighbours, sharing their lives and God's love to bring the community

together and to see young people expressing the full potential God has given them. One of the main highlights over the past year has been the expansion of the team with Matt and Kate joining them and who are from the local area. This means the work on the ground has been extended, which has been amazing! They now run weekly girls' and boys' groups, a monthly Bible study for young people, bi-monthly open mic nights, employability workshops, a community cafe and a football project. They have had the opportunity to pray with some of the local people at their open mic nights.
