Kerry Stillman

Kerry works in Cameroon as part of a church-planting team working among the Fulbe people who are traditionally Muslim. Kerry and her team used to live in the north of the country where, as well as being involved in church planting, they ran a hospital. In 2014 because of the security situation in the north, the team moved further south, where they have continued their ministry of church-planting, and at the same time continue to oversee the work of the hospital.

Kerry is currently on home leave and spending time catching up with friends and family, relaxing and sharing about her work in Cameroon. If you would like to hear more, come along on Thursday evening this week (7.30pm in the Pierce Hall) when Kerry will be sharing more about her work.

- that the Fulbe continue to open their hearts to Jesus and the Gospel
- for the Discovery Bible study groups that are going on, and the Fulbe believers who are leading others to Christ (especially Y, S, J and A)
- that the hospital continues to provide a great service to the community and gives seekers an opportunity to hear about Jesus

- that the seeds of the Gospel that are planted find good soil, and that the Fulbe church will multiply in numbers
- For Aisha, a new lady Fulbe believer who has been rejected by her family, that she will be welcomed into the community by other Fulbe believers
- for Kerry, as she visits supporters in the UK, that she will be able to encourage them to continue standing with her in prayer and support
