John and Suzi Peachey



John and Suzi Peachey are serving with Youth with A Mission (YWAM) in Harpenden. They teach and mentor younger missionary leaders, and help facilitate the group of senior leaders caring for YWAM teams in England. They lead the ministry of *Orphans Know More*, which places orphans (often due to HIV/AIDS) with families in Uganda. Their four (now adult) children are Seth, Joel, Naomi and Lily. John is working towards a PhD through the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies.

Latest news from John and Suzi:

A team of nine of us just returned from Uganda visiting *Orphans Know More* Families. We brought photos dating as far back as 2005 as gifts to the parents, most of whom do not have photos of their children. Their responses were deeply moving. One widow, who is HIV positive, on seeing the images, realised she had forgotten how desperate her life had been and poured out her thanks to God and all of us. Another mother had tragically lost two sons and wept as she held their pictures. She cares for many children, including Laszlo (11), who is blind, and profoundly mentally and physically disabled. An OKM father, Sam, is reaching an impoverished village by starting a primary school. We visited the school and brought a desktop computer. This year OKM received an additional 17 children, some of whom are refugees from the war in South Sudan.

We finished staffing the YWAM Europe Leadership Training School for 95 YWAM leaders in Europe.

John is still helping to lead the University of the Nations Masters in Christian Formation and Discipleship.

- For all the orphans over the past 12 years who now have families and homes
- That the YWAM Europe Leadership Training was so well-received, that another module is planned for next June
- For the new primary school that has been set up in an impoverished village
