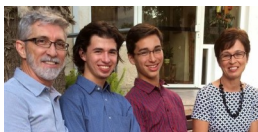
Bernie and Celia Mascher live in Naivasha, Kenya, and manage vocational training courses and a school, train church leaders, and lead a church fellowship.
