Ann-Marie Wilson

Ann-Marie is the founding Executive Director of the charity *28 Too Many* which has the ambitious goal of reducing Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) by 10% in 10 countries in 10 years. She became a Pioneer Lay Minister in the Church of England last summer.

Latest news from Ann-Marie:

"28 Too Many has undergone many changes over the past year and, despite challenges, I think it has ended the year stronger than it was 12 months ago, and ready to tackle the tasks ahead of it.

My licensing as a Pioneer Lay Minister last year makes it easier for me to be invited to talk/preach in churches across London, and in fact across the country. I was very happy to be back at CMS last term, teaching on the MA Pioneer course. It was wonderful to see so much enthusiasm amongst the new students who were learning about pioneering leadership from three of us, pioneering in very different contexts.

On a personal front, I have felt drawn to additionally extend my ministry in parallel to 28 Too Many, although I will, of course, continue to lead it and remain an integral member of the senior team and Board. I have become involved with the Marie Curie Hospice in Hampstead and visit them as part of their chaplaincy team on a voluntary basis. I also visit up to five people in hospital or at home each week with communion.

We proudly launched our new website towards the end of last year. It provides a range of research and resources to assist those working to end FGM. I have attended a coaching course in Germany this week, and next week is our charity Board meeting. Later this month I will be speaking at an FGM event, 'Tackle Africa'. In February I will be attending Oblate Training at Malling Abbey, and will be in Germany again at a coaching course."
