

# St Barnabas Mission Partners



**Pedro & Annu Santos,** and their sons Daniel and Yonatan, work with CMJ in Tel Aviv, Israel. They run a busy and demanding guest house, called Beit Immanuel, and have the responsibility for three congregations that meet there. These include a Messianic Jewish congregation which is approximately 50% Russian, an Arabic congregation, and an Armenian congregation. Annu is developing a counselling ministry.

#### Latest news from the Santoses:

Currently fire sprinklers are being installed in Beit Immanuel, and they do not have a maintenance man, so Pedro has to do that job as well many others.

Pedro therefore has many demands on his time, and so has to wear different hats for a complexity of different tasks

Daniel is applying for residency in Israel - this is not given easily. Pedro has collected several letters of reference and will be going with Daniel later this month to the Ministry of Interior.

Israel, doesn't easily grant residency status, so a small miracle is needed here but if he is not granted this, he might have to come to the UK.

Daniel wants to stay in Israel, (as do the whole family), as he wants to volunteer to join the IDF (Israel Defence Force)

Daniel considers Israel as his home and wants the opportunity to give something back to this special country

Pedro says time is going so quickly and there is just so much to do!
