About Malcolm and Kerstin Grav:

The Gravs work with WEC International in Thailand where they lead a team of around 40 missionaries reaching the unreached, mainly in the rural areas, through church planting. They live around 5 hours drive north of Bangkok. Their daughter Amy has been attending Grace International School in Chiangmai, three hours from Malcolm and Kerstin.

Latest news from the Gravs:

"The last few months have been very difficult. In January one of the WEC Thailand children, Ellen, died suddenly due to a severe asthma attack. Of course this was a deep shock to our whole fellowship, and especially Ellen's family. In the midst of this tragedy, it was beautiful to see people supporting one another in their grief, doing what they could to help.

Soon after this, for personal reasons and after more than 15 years in Thailand, we made the difficult decision to return to the UK and will be back by the end of March. This decision has been very difficult knowing that God called us to Thailand many years ago. We had already sensed that God was leading us to transition back to the UK by about July 2019 once we had handed over the Branch Leader role to the next leaders. This will now take place sooner than we or the Thailand Branch expected. There are still many uncertainties about what lies ahead. Thank you for your prayers during this sudden period of transition."


