Annette Jandrell has worked with Youth with a Mission (YWAM) since 2000: she spent 8 years in Cambodia and has been based in Harpenden. England, since 2009. The aim of her ministry is 'To see communities transformed and released from poverty into the abundant life that God intends for them'. She does this by leading a 6 month Community Development School (CDS), which equips and prepares participants from developing countries for community development ministry in their own communities. She also runs Community Development seminars at different YWAM locations in the world.

Latest news from Annette:

"I have recently returned from a 6 week trip to Togo, West Africa, where 2 of the students from the 2017 Community Development School (CDS) went to do the course practical. During my time in Togo, I facilitated the students' scheduling and activities; ran a couple of workshops on community development; had several good conversations where I encouraged people to consider taking the Community Development School in Togo in September; shared more on community development with the YWAM staff of Noepe campus; spoke at a local church, and facilitated a team-building workshop with the health clinic team.

As much as I love being 'on the field' (apart from the heat and humidity!), I was ready to come home this time. I need to concentrate on other things. For work: planning for the next CDS in Togo; my role in the Training Leadership Team; taking community development seminars in the Netherlands, Northern Ireland and Harpenden; member care (including oversight of applicant medicals).

And on a personal level: I have a wedding to plan! Martyn proposed to me on Boxing Day and we are going to get married in June in the chapel on the YWAM Oval in Harpenden.'
