They lead the ministry of Orphans Know More, which places orphans (often due to HIV/AIDS) with families in Uganda. Their four (now adult) children are Seth, Joel, Naomi and Lily. John is working towards a PhD throuah the Oxford Centre for Mission Studies

"Life is busy! Our time in Cape Town recently was very good. We came back to an empty nest for the first time ever but within 2 days our niece arrived to stay for 10 days and we have had others staying, so not quite so quiet!

Naomi co-wrote a song on her DTS that has just been released. Lily is fine in Bristol, loves her church and enjoys the art course, but has decided she doesn't want to pursue an art degree - she's a light amongst her art course friends in her own quiet way. Joel is happy in Bath and planning a uni student outreach this summer to Uganda - he's recruiting a small team from different unis. Seth is doing fine and is exploring the possibility of moving to Reading from the country.

I (Suzi) am doing well and feel that this time of my life is giving to people and connecting with and encouraging them, reaching out to both those who don't yet know the Lord and continuing to disciple those that do, and mentoring vounger YWAM leaders and mothers. John feels that for the next 18 months he needs to considerably increase his focus on his PhD. We are leading a residential for the YWAM Cambridge Leadership Team here in Harpenden; and then we are going to Norway to speak to a conference of Christian leaders there."
