Ann-Marie Wilson

Ann-Marie Wilson is the founding Executive Director of the charity *28 Too Many* which has the ambitious goal of reducing Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) by 10% in 10 countries in 10 years. She became a Pioneer Lay Minister in the Church of England last summer.

Latest news from Ann-Marie:

"28 Too Many has had an exciting start to the New Year and continues to be a valued resource for people seeking to know and understand more about the issue. I have been on a coaching course over the past 3 months, and the skills that I have learned will help me to be more effective in my work with 28 Too Many. I am grateful for the many opportunities I have been given to speak about the work of 28 Too Many, including the Hogan Lovells' launch of the "Stop FGM" booklet. The 28 Too Many research team continue to work hard on our country profile reports and The Law and FGM.

On a personal note, I am very thankful for the medical team that care for me so well, and I have now completed my chemotherapy treatment after 2 years and 24 sessions.

I have been kept very busy and thank God always for the support I receive from those around me, both practically and in prayer. I regularly go for retreats to Malling Abbey, which is a home from home for me. It gives me space to re-energise and to reflect on what God is calling me to do. They have asked me to train as an Oblate sister, via being a postulant for 6 months, then a novice for 2 and a half years.

Please pray for guidance as I step away from some of the day to day management of 28 Too Many and embrace the roles of internal leadership, external FGM expert, key speaker and author.

I have been volunteering as a chaplain at Marie Curie Hospice once a week. I continue to give communion and pray with those who are unwell in the Parish."
