Pedro & Annu Santos, and their sons Daniel and Yonatan, work with CMJ in Tel Aviv, Israel. They run a busy and demanding guest house, called Beit Immanuel, and have the responsibility for three congregations that meet there. These include a Messianic Jewish congregation which is approximately 50% Russian, an Arabic congregation, and an Armenian congregation. Annu is developing a counselling ministry.

Latest news from the Santos:

- God provided us with an amazing crew of workers who did a good job installing the Fire Sprinklers and were very careful with our old building.
- We are planning to come to the UK this July and hope to see all the saints at St Bs.
- Beit Immanuel still needs some serious and urgent restoration work to be done. Pray that the finances will come.
- Daniel is still applying for residency in Israel, and we are still waiting for some papers and truly we need a small miracle here, as the State of Israel doesn't grant residency status very easily.

Give thanks for:

- Alex & Igor who worked for Beit Immanuel and heard the message of salvation every day for two months
- Hundreds of Israelis who visit Beit Immanuel and hear about Yeshua/Jesus the Messiah
- The growth in the congregation: one Brazilian lady joined last month, and there are quite a number of South African Jews too

Please pray:

- For wisdom to decide if Pedro can attend, and speak at, a conference in Brazil and also fit in a visit to his 84 year old Mum who he hasn't seen for almost 5 years
- For a miracle for Daniel to be granted residency status in Israel
- The business license is due to be renewed in June this year. With these unexpected extra expenses, Beit Immanuel's finances have gone into the red – please pray for provision
