Message from Henry about last Sunday's sermon

I want to make a correction and apologise for a mistake in my sermon last Sunday. I said that Darius the Great cancelled the funding of the Jerusalem temple rebuilding, which he did in 522BC. However after a letter from Tattenai, governor of Trans-Euphrates, was sent to Darius (Ezra 5), a search of the Persian archives resulted in Darius reinstating full support for the temple project (instituted by Cyrus), including the funding (Ezra 6) in 520BC. So whilst at the start of Darius' reign the situation for the remnant Jews in Jerusalem had deteriorated (as I said), this was reversed by the reinstatement of the Cyrus edict by Darius. There was then an opportunity to complete the temple project, which is when Haggai started to prophesy.
