Kerry Stillman

Kerry works in Cameroon as part of a church-planting team working among the Fulbe people who are traditionally Muslim. Kerry and her team used to live in the north of the country where, as well as being involved in church planting, they ran a hospital. In 2014, because of the security situation in the north, the team moved further south, where they have continued their ministry of church-planting, and at the same time continue to oversee the work of the hospital.

Latest news from Kerry:

"It seems that we are entering a new phase of training others to reach out to the Fulbe people. In the past few months we have started to train 3 different groups (20 people) in disciple-making strategy.

On 5 May there will be the largest gathering of Fulbe Christians that there has ever been in Cameroon, meeting to celebrate and dedicate the printing of the Arabic-script Fulfulde Bible (language of the Fulbe), after many years of work by our Bible translator friends. This Bible will be really useful in drawing Fulbe who only read Arabic script to God's Word.

Fulbe followers of Jesus are starting to network more with each other from different parts of Cameroon. It's great to see them wanting to help each other in their walk with Jesus.

Seeker MT has been searching to learn about Jesus for a few years and now he is absorbing the Bible like a sponge! His heart is receiving Jesus as Good News. He gets married this week, so pray that his new wife will be open to Jesus too."
