Linda Perkins came back to the UK from China in February 2017, where she had worked teaching English at a major university for nearly 20 years. She has shared with and impacted many people over the vears.

Latest news from Linda:

"In the aftermath of the loss of my Dad last November, we spent a large amount of time sorting out his estate (which is ongoing) and working, together with the care provider, to find a suitable schedule for my mother's care. The combination of these has meant I needed to be in Wales, so I had to give up my proposed role with Friends International. I am hands-on with Mum, and am enjoying being in Wales with family.

As I work out what God has for my future, I have had the pleasure of starting to serve at my local church here in Abergavenny. I have enjoyed a variety of voluntary roles, including speaking about China to house groups and other groups, eg the local Mothers' Union; evangelistic opportunities eg a Kidz Holiday Club; developing a series of Seekers' Courses for those interested in finding out more about the Lord, and a Training the Trainers programme in late May; starting prayer groups, one for the Persecuted Church and another to cover the Kidz Club programmes, besides speaking at women's events. The church here has also asked me to participate as a Volunteer Pastoral Worker

A highlight has been to begin to help other people who are returning from overseas work, including talks at transition groups and seminars. To help me to take this role further, I am considering studying an MA in Member Care at Redcliffe College, Gloucester. I would love to find a part-time job locally that meets my skill set, but they don't appear to exist. Wisdom needed!"
