They also run Little Hands School which integrates children with physical disabilities and other special needs. On Sundays they lead Naivasha International Fellowship.

Latest news from the Maschers

"We had a lovely Easter break with the kids, although it seems a long time ago now! We didn't do much, mainly hung out at home. We've been travelling so much lately, getting on planes here and there, that it was nice to have nowhere to go for a while. We surprised the kids by getting a new German shepherd puppy at the beginning of the holiday. Her name is Sheba. She's very cute.

Little Hands School has started well, with no major hiccups so far. We've had a few new children join this term, especially in the 'Ducklings Daycare' (the three year olds). We have 30 children in that class now. We have also interviewed and assessed two more children with special needs: one with spina bifida, and one with autism. We've tried to pause a bit on the number of disabled children we accept, as we have limited resources (especially people), but it's hard to say 'no'. We always fall in love with the kids too, which makes it even harder.

We're planning to be in London briefly in July (13-19 July), on our way to Canada. I (Celia) have a check-up and treatment planned, and then we'll visit my parents, too. I hope we'll be able to pop into St Bs at some point."
