WORK: "We're so thankful for a great day at GOFest in May - a one day mission event Global Connections organises for those interested or considering world mission, held at All Nations Christian College. 300 people came for an inspiring day with dynamic speakers and a fast-moving programme on a wide range of themes.

Having been without an Executive Director for 6 months, the Board of Global Connections are close to making an appointment. We are also advertising for a number of other posts, including a Chief Operating Officer - so it's a time of significant change for our team.

I'll be overseeing our SERVICEstation team at events over the summer, including 3 weeks at the Keswick Convention; we still need to fill some gaps in the teams "

FAMILY: "My mum has just had major back surgery and I am thankful my diary has been clear enough for me to be able to care for her after coming out of hospital. She has a number of health problems, so we've been amazed and thankful to God for how well she's doing."

OTHER MINISTRY: "We're delighted to have just completed training for 17 new recruits to our City Pastors team, after losing a number of team members last year. This has been a great boost to us as we continue our vital work in Birmingham's night-time economy every weekend.'


