Annette Jandrell has worked with Youth with a Mission (YWAM) since 2000; she spent 8 years in Cambodia and has been based in Harpenden, England, since 2009. The aim of her ministry is: 'To see communities transformed and released from poverty into the abundant life that God intends for them'. She does this by leading a 6 month Community Development School (CDS), which equips and prepares participants from developing countries for community development ministry in their own communities. She also runs Community Development seminars at different YWAM locations in the world. Annette is getting married NEXT Saturday, 9 June, to Martyn.

"I have recently stepped down from the Training Leadership Team at YWAM Harpenden so that I can concentrate on my wedding preparations; on preparing for the next Community Development School (CDS); and on my other roles as YWAM Harpenden Medical Officer, and leading Britcare, the member care service for British YWAMers overseas.

I have led two community development seminars so far this year; one was during the Children at Risk School in The Netherlands, and the other was at a church in Belfast.
