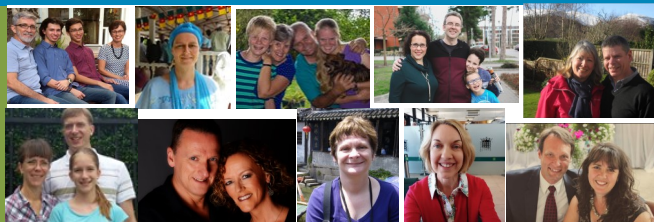




St Bs Mission Partners

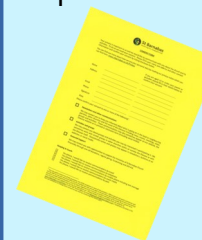
If you are a newcomer and would like more information, then please take and complete one of our **Connect Forms**, which you will find at the back of church and in the Offering Baskets as they come round.
