The other day, all her classmates decided this was by far the best way to move and all crawled along beside her – getting very dirty in the process!

Our church has been growing! It's been exciting to see. We've had numerous visitors in the last few weeks even though many of our regular family are away for the summer. But sadly some key members are moving to other locations, other jobs. We'll need to find others to fill the vacancies they have left.

We got a new puppy at the beginning of the Easter holidays - a German shepherd called 'Sheba'. She is very friendly and sociable and has grown enormously since we got her!"

We had a good stopover in the UK and loved catching up with friends at St Bs last Sunday. We are now spending the summer in Canada, catching up with family and supporters."
