Pedro & Annu Santos, and their sons Daniel and Yonatan, work with CMJ in Tel Aviv, Israel. They run a busy and demanding quest house, called Beit Immanuel, and have the responsibility for three congregations that meet there. These include a Messianic Jewish congregation which is approximately 50% Russian, an Arabic congregation, and an Armenian congregation. Annu is developing a counselling ministry.

#### Latest news from the Santos's:

"We have an Open House Event this weekend (22 and 23 September) at Beit Emmanuel Tel Aviv. This is the 12<sup>th</sup> year it has been running, and thousands of Israelis are expected to visit. However there have been problems with our computer and e-mails, and we are working hard on getting it sorted"

Give thanks for:

- For the things God is doing in Israel. Congregations are growing both Jewish and Arab ones. There is a real love between believers in the Lord
- For Daniel's residency. We have been praying for about three years, standing with the Santos's in the gap for their family, and God has had mercy on them and has answered our prayers
- For the extension of Beit Immanuel's business licence. And for the incredible opportunity to share about Jesus with Asaph, one of the managers of the Tel Aviv Municipality

#### Please pray:

- For the outreach they are preparing towards the Arab community this Autumn. There have been some amazing openings and the Arab brothers have asked for help from the Messianic Jews
- For the restoration of Beit Immanuel. There is only so much patching up that can be done to their old building
- For a breakthrough in the finances that are needed in this project
- For wisdom as they tackle the difficulties of dealing with bureaucracy in Israel
