Roger and Shireen West are evangelists who live in Kenya and travel to the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) to hold open air campaigns in unreached areas, and teach pastors and leaders. They have two adult sons, Tim and Josh.

They will soon be doing another outreach in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and they thank God for helping them get everything ready for the trip, including visas, truck and vehicles. The country is awaiting the announcement of the election results. The Wests may have travelled to the DRC by the time you pray.

Please pray that:

- The Lord will keep the doors open for them, and that the country will stay calm and peaceful, no matter what the results of the election
- Visas for their American team of Pastors will be granted
- Many lives will be changed as the Word of God is preached and taught, and for miracles and healings.
- They will be a blessing to the prisoners at the 2 prisons they will visit
- The team stay well and safe



Abi and Pipe Figueroa serve God in Colombia with Latin Link. Pipe holds several leadership roles, including temporarily taking on Abi's responsibilities so she can focus on looking after Chloe, their baby girl. They are leaders of "Nations Network", a mission ministry running in their church to train up and support Colombian missionaries.

Pipe has taken on a couple of new roles since the Figueras returned to Bogotá in August, after 6 months in England. He is now the National team leader of Latin Link, which involves organising the bi-annual Latin Link team meetings with all Colombians (the first took place in November) and other responsibilities in team member care and support. He has also taken on Abi's role as Short Term Coordinator, which involves facilitating short term mission opportunities for Colombians and receiving British and European volunteers to work alongside the Colombian church. Pipe has also been preaching at a mission school in Bogotá in his role as Missions Mobiliser (training up and sending out Colombian missionaries).

Abi has been helping to set up their new home in Bogotá, as well as care for Chloe, who has been taking longer to adapt to Colombia than they thought. She hopes to establish a local mothers and toddlers network outreach at some point.

Please pray that:

- Chloe can sleep well through the night, and for energy for Abi and Pipe
- Pipe can depend on God and have wisdom and strength in all his roles
- There is openness in the Colombian church for mobilising Colombians into mission
- Abi finds the right timing and support to set up a local mothers and toddlers network


