Annette Goddard (nee Jandrell)

has worked with Youth with a Mission (YWAM) since 2000; she spent 8 years in Cambodia and has been based in Harpenden, England, for the past 10 years, where she has been leading 6-month Community Development Schools (CDS).

These have consisted of lectures and a field assignment in a developing country to equip participants from various countries to walk alongside communities and help them develop physically, spiritually and in wisdom. She is in a period of transition at the moment (see below), following her marriage to Martyn Goddard last summer.

Latest news from Annette:

Martyn and I are looking to leave YWAM Harpenden by the end of August.

Martyn is actively seeking work within the world of car dealerships. I will no longer be leading the Community Development School (CDS), but am looking to continue to teach Biblical community development through home and field-based seminars (within and outside of YWAM).

'Transition' is a tough place to be, but we are seeking the way forward and praying for the right door to open; not just for a 'job', but into a new season and ministry roles for both of us in the place the Lord wants us to be.

We are also conscious that this is a time of learning to abide in Christ, a time of 'being transformed by the renewal of the mind', and a time of learning together how to press in to the Lord as a couple.

- For the ministry Annette has been faithfully involved in over many years, and the effect she has had on both individuals and communities
- That Annette and Martyn are able to live at YWAM Harpenden whilst Martyn looks for a job and a place for them both to live
- That Annette and Martyn are growing through this difficult time of transition and trusting the Lord for guidance

- Martyn to get a fulfilling job where he will be able to use his skills and abilities
- Provision for Annette and Martyn whilst Martyn looks for a job


