Ann-Marie Wilson is the founding Executive Director of the charity *28 Too Many* which has the ambitious goal of reducing Female Genital Mutilation (FGM) by 10% in 10 countries in 10 years. She is a Pioneer Lay Minister in the Church of England.

Latest news from Ann-Marie:

I have been suffering with lower back and hip pain since early February. A scan identified multiple stress fractures in the hip area and I saw an Orthopaedic Surgeon who recommended that all mobility be via crutches and wheelchair in the next 2-4 weeks. I may need further injections or a hip replacement.

This year has begun with several key police meetings for us, as well as plans to continue our law project to create a model law. We worked alongside BBDO, an advertising agency, to produce and promote a new anti-FGM 'ribbon' for Zero Tolerance to FGM Day in February. The symbol represents the word 'no'.

On International Women's Day in March, we published the fifteenth (of twenty eight) country reports on Somalia and Somaliland. We have had lots of positive feedback so far and hope these will be used to influence change with policy makers and grassroots activists. Our next report, on Sudan, will be out later in the year along with our next thematic report on FGM & Anthropology in Arabic.

I am starting to write up the story of *28 Too Many* over the next few months, to record the journey God has taken me on.

I have a lot of work and personal travel planned for the coming weeks.

Please be praying for wisdom as I and the *28 Too Many* team decide how to resource/defer commitments accordingly. I went on a trip to Japan in April and am looking forward to holiday in Switzerland at the end of May.

- For the team at *28 Too Many*, who work tirelessly to produce high quality reports for specific countries and on particular topics
- For the Board of Trustees, who give their time freely to ensure that the charity continues to be an effective force for change
- That Ann-Marie's health was sufficiently stable so that she could go on a lifetime dream holiday to Japan in April

- For young girls and women who have to contend with pressure from their families and others to comply with harmful practices
- For guidance on what form the write-up of some of the story behind *28 Too Many* should take
- That Ann-Marie's health continues to be stable and that she is able to control the pain and fatigue that have become part of everyday life
