It's currently working on both the Strawberry Vale estate and The Grange estate; and it plans to work on the Market Place/Prospect Ring estates in the future as well. Our vision is to work with the local communities to see transformation that lasts.

Latest news from Hope North London:

This term we have just started detached children's and youth work on The Grange estate, which has proved challenging as we don't have a building! The groups are very popular and we've made some great connections with both kids and parents.

Our mid-week groups on Strawberry Vale are still popular after running for many years. The groups have been a great way of building long-term relationships on the estate. We are so pleased that Emma Kafero (part-time youth worker at St Bs) is going to be working with us throughout Elise's maternity leave. We really hope that this will continue to build strong bridges between St Barnabas and Hope North London.

Plans are coming together well for the Enterprise Programme. We're waiting to hear back from a significant grant-making charity while putting in further applications for funding. We're keen to get the programme and the Enterprise Café (at St Bs) up and running as quickly as we can.

The last six months have been a very turbulent time for the team, with two members off sick with serious illnesses and other team members incapacitated. This has put extra pressure on the team, who have responded amazingly well with making sure all of our activities are covered.
