Annette Goddard (nee Jandrell) was leading the Community Development School (CDS) at Youth with a Mission (YWAM) in Harpenden until her and husband Martyn's recent move to the Isle of Man. Annette continues to teach and promote Biblical community development through field-based seminars in YWAM Schools/ministry locations and outside of YWAM on more of a part-time basis, as well as support on the occasional CDS.

Latest news from Annette:

We had been sensing that it was time to move off the YWAM base in Harpenden for some time, so when Martyn was offered a job on the Isle of Man that matched his passions and skills just before our leaving deadline (the end of August), we felt that this was where God was leading us for the next season.

We managed to find an apartment within two days of arriving on the Isle of Man via a contact at the church we visited our first Sunday on the island. We were very grateful to our friends who loaded a van and brought all our belongings from Harpenden to us on the ferry.

I taught a week long Community Development seminar in India in August, and have more seminars lined up to teach in October, November and possibly December (funding dependent).

Martyn's job involves very long hours, split days off, and Sunday working, leaving very little time for 'us', church, recreation, etc, so we would like to see a change with that.

Annette will be moving on from being a St Bs Mission Partner at the end of September, but we are looking at supporting her in other ways in the future.
