Latest news from Richard:

I recently returned from Vienna, where I was at a conference of Catholics. Protestants and Messianic Jews. Our aim was to help the whole church understand more of the riches of its Jewish heritage of faith, and the exciting significance of a growing number of Jewish disciples of Jesus around the world and in every stream of the church

At Jews for Jesus we are going through challenging times with great opportunities. We have a team of about six people helping Christians witness to their Jewish friends, understanding the Jewish roots of their faith, and growing as disciples; we hope to have three young Israelis joining us shortly. We are looking to move out of our present premises in Hendon to find more appropriate space in a better location for ministry; and we are starting a weekly podcast, "Jew in the Pew", about Jewish disciples of Jesus and the issues that affect them.

My wife Monica needs to watch her energy levels but loves helping Rebekah and lain with our three grandchildren, who live in High Barnet. I have a problem with my knee and might need an operation.
