Refresh is a community for parents and carers of 0-2s that launched in January. We include a thought based on a Bible verse as part of our meeting which is mostly attended by families who would not otherwise find themselves in church. We have created a culture of belonging before believing and want to bless the families by exceeding their expectations. Each week we use a countdown as a prompt to gather together and pause play for a few minutes to listen to one of the team share a short thought. They are so keen to hear the message that we have to stop the timer before the 2 minutes is up! After listening, there is at least one adult who comments, "That was exactly what I needed to hear today." We watch God move and tears fall when someone's life is being touched by his Spirit and then we offer to pray for them. Beautiful!
